All courses provided by Planetshakers College are accredited by the Sydney College of Divinity.




PLANETSHAKERS COLLEGE

COURSES OFFERED

OCC offers a wide range of courses at both the undergraduate and postgraduate levels. For this inaugural year, the following accredited courses are being offered:

- Undergraduate: Diploma of Leadership
- Postgraduate: Graduate Diploma of Arts and Master of Arts

These programmes are part of broader course pathways that lead to completing either a Bachelors or a Masters programme, which are designed to equip students with both scriptural knowledge and practical skills. The abovementioned programmes will be available this year for our prospective students.



UNDERGRADUATE

Diploma of Leadership:

Year 01

The Diploma of Leadership is the foundational year for students. Students completing the Diploma of Leadership will have read through the entire Bible, prepared and delivered a sermon, completed a course on the Foundations of Christian Doctrine, grown in their relationship with God, studied and received input from world class leaders and undertaken practical training through faithful servanthood in the various ministries and events of the church.

Subjects outline:

- Survey of the Old Testament
- · Survey of the New Testament
- Introduction to Christian Doctrines
- Introduction to Christian Leadership
- Supervised Ministry 1
- · Person & Work of the Holy Spirit
- Basics of Pastoral Preaching
- Transformational Leadership

Full Time: 1 Year

(weekly classes, 4 subjects per semester)

Part Time: 2 Years

(monthly class, 2 subjects per semester)

SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

» SURVEY OF THE OLD & NEW TESTAMENT

Go deeper in God's word through a thorough survey of the scriptures across two semesters. Students will be equipped with basic exegetical strategies to understand Scripture and be challenged to apply the truths of Scripture to their personal lives and contemporary situations. One semester is spent on each the Old and New Testament.

» INTRODUCTION TO CHRISTIAN DOCTRINES

The foundations are the most important part of any building. Introduction to Christian Doctrines is the foundational unit of this programme, offering a comprehensive introduction to theology designed to help students build a strong foundation for their growing faith. Learn what the Bible has to say about God, Creation and the Fall, the nature of humanity, angels and demons, the atonement and resurrection of Christ and much more.

» INTRODUCTION TO CHRISTIAN LEADERSHIP

Introduction to Christian Leadership allows students to explore the foundations of leadership and build strong, practical skills to be an exceptional leader in today's climate. Students are taught the traits and behaviours of biblically sound leadership, how to identify leaders in the real world and in turn, how to develop oneself as a leader.

» SUPERVISED MINISTRY 1

An internship unit that allows students to learn the practice of ministry in the local church setting. This unit will build important skills regardless of which vocation students plan to pursue. Students may choose to pursue an internship in areas including the following: pastoral care, creative ministry, youth ministry and children's ministry. This subject requires oversight from the referring church in order to provide a mentor for the student.

» PERSON & WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

This unit is a central part of the Diploma of Leadership and deals with the Pentecostal distinctives and philosophy of ministry. Students will study and prepare assessments about the Holy Spirit, but more than that, students will be trained to operate in the miraculous gifts of the Spirit. Each lecture and tutorial has both a scriptural and practical component which will encourage students to grow in their understanding of the move of the Spirit in an environment of encounter.

» BASICS OF PASTORAL PREACHING

Basics of Pastoral Preaching is a unit which equips students with the tools to develop their communication skills. Not only do students learn about the art of preaching but they are given the tools to differentiate between skill and operating under the anointing. Students learn to tailor sermons in response to a variety of contexts and operate with the Holy Spirit in delivering the Gospel message. Basics of Pastoral Preaching is assessed by delivering a testimony, a sermon and a speech.

» TRANSFORMATIONAL LEADERSHIP

Transformational Leadership is a unit focused on self-leadership and personal discipleship. Students are taught spiritual disciplines, character integrity and basic self and small group leadership principles to equip them to serve the church in greater capacity. This subject requires weekly readings. Transformational Leadership is assessed by weekly quizzes, an essay and a leadership development plan.

POSTGRADUATE

Graduate Diploma of Arts

Year 01

The Graduate Diploma of Arts is an award designed to give students who have completed Bachelor studies in disciplines other than theology the opportunity to deepen their knowledge in the Bible, theology, leadership and ministry. Additionally, the Graduate Diploma of Arts can act as an entry level point for those who wish to start their journey towards becoming a Master Degree graduate.

Through the completion of the Graduate Diploma of Arts, students will continue to be challenged academically, while further refining their leadership and culture shaping skills as they continue to draw close to God through service and encounter.

Students enrolling for the first time will be exposed to foundational principles for personal and professional leadership, ministry and theology. Students will be equipped to lead in their spheres of influence, whilst being grounded in a robust biblical and theological foundation.

Students will be given the opportunity to practise Christian leadership principles in their chosen ministry stream, solidifying theoretical principles with practical experience.

SUBJECT DESCRIPTION

» BASIC CHRISTIAN DOCTRINES

This course unit introduces students to the foundational doctrines of the Christian tradition, enabling them to explore and evaluate the distinctives of their faith within the context and shape of that tradition. It provides a critical foundation for all future theology course units.

» INTRODUCTION TO THE OLD TESTAMENT

This course unit introduces students to the critical study of the Old Testament, its literary forms, historical and cultural contexts and theological themes. It provides a solid foundation for further biblical and theological study.

» INTRODUCTION TO THE STUDY OF CHRISTIAN HISTORY

The Christian church is an evolving institution, which has constantly acted and reacted in terms of its own developing sense of identity, and in terms of its historical and social context. In this way, the theology and the ecclesiology of the church have come to assume their current shapes. This introduction to the study of church history equips students with methods of historical inquiry applied to an analysis of the church's doctrinal and institutional evolution as a framework for other theological study and more advanced historical study.

» SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

This course unit is designed to challenge and inspire students to actively serve as spiritual leaders. It will examine the significant ways that secular leadership intersects with biblical principles and values, examine their current approach to leadership, and reflect on how they might lead at a higher level.

» INTRODUCTION TO THE NEW TESTAMENT

This course unit introduces students to the critical study of the New Testament, its literary forms, historical and cultural contexts and theological themes. It provides a solid foundation for further biblical and theological study.

» CHRISTOLOGY AND SOTERIOLOGY

This course unit is designed to provide students with an understanding of the person and saving work of Jesus Christ. It seeks to explore this understanding in the light of contemporary Christian thought and life.

» PNEUMATOLOGY

This course unit is designed to provide students with an understanding of the person and work of the Holy Spirit (Pneumatology). It seeks to explore this understanding in light of contemporary Christian thought and experience.

» TRANSFORMATIONAL LEADERSHIP IN MINISTRY

This course unit examines the nature and practice of leadership which has personal and organisational transformation as its primary object. Participants will be challenged to develop a biblical model of leadership based on Jesus' ministry, and to develop an intentional strategy for their own ongoing spiritual and personal nourishment.

POSTGRADUATE

Master of Arts

18 months with Graduate Diploma of Arts

The Master of Arts is a coursework masters degree where students will select from advanced units in Bible, theology, Ministry and Leadership. The Master of Arts is designed for maximum flexibility so that students can choose subjects according to their own interest and calling.

COURSE OUTCOMES

Students who completed the Master of Arts will have:

- An integrated understanding of an advanced body of knowledge in one
 or more theologically-related disciplines or areas of practice, including
 recent developments in the theological disciplines and/or their practice.
- Understanding research principles and methods applicable to these theological disciplines and their practice.

INTERNSHIP WITH THE LOCAL CHURCH (ILC)

FAQs

Is an English proficiency test required to apply for the courses?

If the student has completed a degree or A/L's in English, they won't be required to do an English proficiency test. However we will require transcripts from their studies as proof when applying. The final decision will be at the discretion of Planetshakers College.

Are the OCC courses accredited?

Yes, all courses at OCC are accredited by the Sydney College of Divinity, based in Australia.

When do applications open?

Applications will open in December 2024 and will close on the 16th of February 2025. Prospective students are required to fill out an Expression of Interest (EOI) form to begin the application process.

Is there an age limit for applicants?

There is no strict age limit; OCC welcomes students from diverse backgrounds and age groups.

Are there scholarships or financial aid options?

Currently, OCC fees are heavily subsidised to make the courses accessible for all. While this may change in the future, OCC is committed to keeping programs affordable.

Who is eligible to apply?

Anyone with a passion for leadership, ministry, and personal growth can apply. Specific entry requirements will be communicated during the application process.
